General Information

NCRCHA FEB 28, MARCH 1 & 2, 2025

Saturday will be all the herd work and cow horse classes. Sunday will be all the ranch horse classes. Please use the appropriate entry form for each show and email to the designated show secretary.

REQUIRED HEALTH DOCUMENTS – The California Department of Food and Agriculture requires a health certificate (Certificate of Veterinary Inspection) dated within 30 days and proof of a negative equine infectious anemia test (Coggins or ELISA) dated within 12 months for out of state horses entering California. See the CDFA website for details. Show management does not require health certificates or Coggins for any horses attending the event. Each horse entered will be required to pay the CDFA Drug fee of \$14.00.

You must be a member of NCRCHA to show.

MOVE IN – No earlier than Thursday February 27, 2025 at 1:00PM MOVE OUT – No later than Monday March 3, 2025 at 12:00PM

SHOW OFFICE HOURS – The show office will be open 1pm – 5 pm on FRIDAY, February 28, 2025. The show office will open at 7 am on show days and close after the last class ends.

IN CATTLE CLASSES ONLY: Scratching after the cattle are ordered forfeits cattle fee in NRCHA & NCRCHA classes; scratch after draw forfeits add back, office fee of \$30.00 and cattle fees in NRCHA & NCRCHA classes; scratch out of a class to add to another class at show is a \$30 change fee & adds at bottom of draw in a new block in order received. To enter and/or reserve cattle please put a credit or debit card on file OR send a personal check. When checking out you can choose to pay with cash, credit or debit card (NO convenience fee), Zeffy or personal check. You may secure your entry with a credit card and pay cash or check at check out. Credit Cards will not be billed until check out.




RANCH RIDING WALK TROT

- 2. EXT. TROT 1/2 way up the ARENA
- 3. TURN LEFT EXT. TROT to Center of ARENA
- 4. TROT CIRCLE to LEFT

- **6. 360 TURN LEFT**
- 7. EXT. TROT
- 8. WALK over RAILS
- 9. STOP / BACK 1 Horse Length

RANCH RIDING - PATTERN 6






- 1. Walk
- 2. Walk over logs
- 3. Lope right lead
- 4. Extended lope right lead
- 5. Trot
- 6. Stop, 11/2 turn right
- 7. Walk
- 8. Trot
- 9. Extended trot
- 10. Lope left lead
- 11. Stop and back 12. Side pass right

RANCH RIDING - PATTERN 4


Ranch Riding - all except 10 and under



- 1. Walk
- 2. Trot
- 3. Extended lope right lead
- 4. Lope right lead
- 5. Change leads (simple or flying)
- 6. Lope left lead
- 7. Extended trot
- 8. Stop, side pass left, side pass right, 1/2 way
- 9. Walk over logs
- 10. Walk
- 11. Trot square
- 12. Stop, 360° turn left, and back



REINING PATTERN 14



Horses may walk or jog to the center of arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

- 1. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate.
- 2. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
- Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
- Complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
- Begin a large circle to the right but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a left rollback at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence—no hesitation.
- Continue back around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the left side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollback at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence—no hesitation.
- 7. Continue back around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence. Back up at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate to demonstrate the completion of the pattern.



- Beginning, lope straight up the right side of the arena, circle the top of the arena run straight down the opposite or left side of the arena past the center mark and do a right rollback—no hesitation.
- Continue straight up the left side of the arena circle back around the top of the arena run straight down the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.
- Continue up the right side of the arena to the center marker, at the center marker the horse should be on the left lead and complete two circles to the left, one large fast and one small slow. Stop at center
- 4. Complete three spins to the left. Hesitate.
- Complete two circles to the right, one large fast and one small slow. Stop at center.
- 6. Complete three spins to the right. Hesitate.
- Begin a large circle to the left, do not close the circle. Continue up the center of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop.
- 8. Back up at least ten feet. Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.
